The purpose of this communication is to serve as a reminder that the **Literacy Test - OSSLT** will be held this week on **May 11th, 2022**, for all eligible students, across all campuses. Students who are not required or eligible to write will either be writing a practice OSSLT or working on SAT review questions.

I would also like to make you aware of some changes to the school year calendar. In order for United Scholastic Academy to meet Ministry Requirements pertaining to Policy and Program Memorandum 151, there will be two Professional Activity Days added, **May 20th, 2022** and **June 22nd, 2022**. Professional learning will include anti-black racism and the intentional disruption of institutional marginalization. Additionally, there will be one additional Examination Day added, **June 23rd, 2022** so that students are not writing more than two exams on a given day.
